

**MEETING MINUTES
CAMPGROUND COMMITTEE MEETING
MARCH 23, 2004**

The campground committee held a meeting on March 23, 2004, at 3:00 p.m. in the Dack Education Room at the Iowa Veterans Home. Present at the meeting were: Dave Harms, Bob Workman, Terry Winders, Rich Stone, and Don Stull.

The first item discussed was where the shuttle pick-up spots would be located. It was decided that the Guard Shack at IVH, the west end of the Softball Complex parking lot, the northwest corner of Lenihan School, and east of the restrooms at Riverview Park would work best for the shuttle drivers.

The next item discussed was the number needed and the placement of the porta potties. The 65 that the Register provides would go to IVH, being split into two groups. Six regular and one handicap go to the east end of the blacktop parking lot at the Little League Complex. Six regular and possibly one handicap go to the northwest parking area of Lenihan School, six regular and one handicap go by the Message Center at Franklin School, and possibly four more go by West End (tennis courts).

It was then discussed about using Franklin Field as an extension of IVH's campground. This should be brought up to the Advisory Board since we will be losing the area of the softball diamonds at the Softball Complex.

Other questions brought up at the meeting were:

- 1) Possibly having a dumpsite put on the city map for RVs. This could save a lot of questions at the campgrounds.
- 2) Will there be some type of uniformed security at the campground sites in case of trouble?
- 3) Is the phone truck our responsibility?

Placement of the portable showers was discussed, and the best spot at IVH would be south of the doctors' houses or, in case of rain, they would go to the east side on the blacktop. At the Little League, they would go by the second manhole cover on the south side of the blacktop parking lot.
