Examples: Most appliances are rated in wattage. If not, multiply the voltage times the amperage. (V times A)  
 A 120 volt roaster at 10 amp = 1,200 VA. Also, **VA equals watts**, (6) 100 watt lamps = 600 watts or 600 VA
