Imagine Marshalltown — 7 big ideas by 2011



Can you Imagine what Marshalltown could be like if we could implement 7 BIG IDEAS by 2011? That is the goal of a community-wide planning initiative that was launched on October 26. It focuses on a grassroots planning process that requires broad citizen involvement. If you can Imagine it, you will be contributing to the future of YOUR community! The key is to get your ideas submitted, and the guidelines are simple:

There are no bad ideas so send them all
Don't worry about what it costs or who will do it
Write down the idea not the details
You don't need to identify whose idea it is

Not only are ideas coming from individuals, but there are also many groups who are taking some meeting time to brainstorm and generate ideas. There have been over 300 ideas submitted so far and more are coming in daily. It is easy to be a part of the process so here are some questions to ask yourself or your group as you brainstorm:

What would make Marshalltown an ideal place to live, work and play?
What is missing here?
What will make you stay here?

You can also be a part of the idea selection process. Applications for the 15-member selection committee are being accepted until December 15, 2006. It is important to note that those citizens who are selected will be chosen in a blind selection process. The applications will be coded and no member of the Imagine Steering Committee will know who has applied for the idea selection committee. The goal is to have a broad-based representation of citizens who will manage the selection of ideas. The general public will also be asked for additional input as the ideas are being processed. 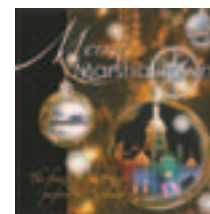

lines – operating with two City appointed board members, two Chamber appointed board members, and five hospitality appointed board members – thus creating an agency that works for the *entire* community's best interest.

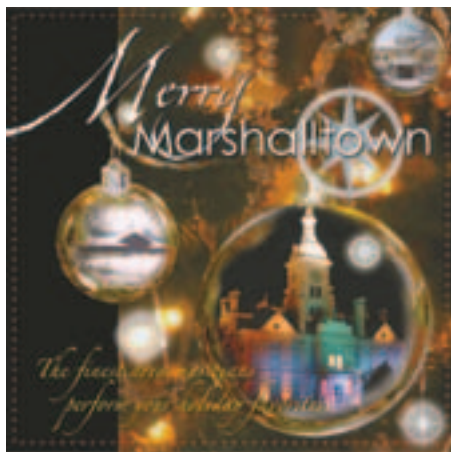
- Tourism is a \$50 million per year industry in Marshall County.
