

### Shopping mall to be renamed

Marshall Town Center will be renamed "Marshalltown Mall" in the coming weeks, as the property continues its revitalization efforts.

A new sign on South Center Street will include the name "Marshalltown Mall", along with selected store identification, coupled with an electronic reader board to promote all of the mall's stores, scheduled sales and events. "Installation of the new sign is scheduled for the end of October or the beginning of November, weather permitting" said Ken Huge, general manager of the shopping center. "At the same time, the current Marshall Town Center sign will be removed."

The commitment of Hobby Lobby to open next year, along with new signage, the initial phase of work on a refreshed façade along Center Street, increased leasing activity, as well as the continued support of ownership and management all leads to one conclusion; Marshalltown Mall is back on the upswing. Huge adds that Schweser's, a regional women's/children's apparel store is slated to open in mid-October, joining two recently opened stores, Storia Bella and Yvonne's T-Shirts and Gifts.

An updated Marshalltown Mall website and Facebook page are also in the works.


Parade line-up will take place at the Farmers Savings Bank parking lot; please line up between 4:30 p.m. and 4:45 p.m.

The Fourth Annual Jean Seberg International Film Festival is set for November 21 – 23, at the IVCCD Orpheum Theater Center in Marshalltown. The theme of this year's three-day event is, "Inspired. Inspiring." with films and symposiums highlighting the things that motivated Jean, as well as how her legacy moves others.

The celebration will kick off Friday night in the Orpheum Black Box Theater where guests can enjoy hors d'oeuvres and champagne. Several awards will be given that night, followed by a movie in the Orpheum Movie House. Tickets for opening night festivities are \$25, with proceeds going to the Jean Seberg Endowment.

## Strategic partnerships bring new business services to Marshall County

The central Iowa Small Business Development Center (SBDCs) provides a vast array of technical assistance to small businesses and aspiring entrepreneurs. By supporting business growth, sustainability and enhancing the creation of new business entities, SBDCs foster local and regional economic development through job creation and retention. As a result of the no cost, extensive, one-on-one, long-term professional business advising, low-cost training and other specialized services SBDC clients receive, the program remains one of the nation's largest small business assistance programs in the federal government. The SBDCs are made up of a unique collaboration of SBA federal funds, state and local governments, and private sector resources.

SBDCs provide services through professional business advisors such as: development of business plans; manufacturing assistance; financial packaging and lending assistance; exporting and importing support; disaster recovery assistance; procurement and contracting aid; market research services; aid to 8(a) firms in all stages; and healthcare information. SBDCs serve all populations, including: minorities; women; veterans, including reservists, active duty, disabled personnel, and those returning from deployment; personal with disabilities; youth and encore entrepreneurs; as well as individuals in low and moderate income urban and rural areas. Based on client needs, local business trends and individual business requirements, SBDCs modify their services to meet the evolving needs of the hundreds of small business community in which they are situated.

Through a strategic partnership between MEDIC and the SBDC, these services will now be available locally on the third Thursday of every month by appointment at the MEDIC offices. As we continue to build up client loads we hope too add additional days in the future. Ted Bair, Director of the Central Iowa SBDC will provide counseling in multiple languages to meet the needs of our diverse population with the assistance of interpreters. Ted has years of counseling experience and has served as interim State Wide Director of the SBDC network. Incumbent Dean Fisher (R) and Ben Westpahl (D) will compete for Iowa State House District 72 seat on election day.

2014 also marks the gubernatorial race between incumbent Governor Terry Branstad (R) and State Senator Jack Hatch (D).
