Washington DC & Williamsburg

DAY 1: ARRIVE WASHINGTON DC AREA

Today arrive in the Washington DC area and meet your Tour Director. Later check into your Washington DC area hotel for your first of two three-night stays. This evening meet your fellow travelers for a **Welcome Dinner**.

DAY 2: WASHINGTON DC SIGHTSEEING

This morning visit **Arlington National Cemetery** to see the Kennedy Grave Sites and famous Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Later enjoy a **Washington DC City Tour** to see many of the city's major highlights including the World War II, Iwo Jima, Korean & Vietnam War Memorials, Capitol Hill and Embassy Row. Make a stop for great views and photos of the White House. Tonight enjoy a **DC Twilight Illumination Tour** of the famous monuments including those dedicated to Lincoln & Jefferson.

DAY 3: U.S. NAVAL ACADEMY - SMITHSONIAN

This morning travel to Annapolis to tour the **U.S. Naval Academy**. Established in 1845, the Naval Academy is the undergraduate college for the Navy and prepares young men and women to become professional officers in the U.S. Navy & Marine Corps. Later visit the world's greatest and largest museum, the **Smithsonian Institution**. Comprised of several spacious museum buildings, the Institution features the well known Air & Space, American History and Natural History Museums among others. Tonight enjoy dinner on your own.

 (B) Overnight: **Washington DC area**

DAY 4: MOUNT VERNON - RICHMOND - WILLIAMSBURG

Enjoy breakfast then travel to **Mount Vernon**, President George Washington's beautiful estate overlooking the Potomac River. The "Father of Our Country" called Mt. Vernon home for more than 45 years. Tour the house and gardens and visit the grave site of our first President. Later drive to **Richmond** to see Virginia's capital and once the capital of the Confederacy. This afternoon arrive in **Williamsburg** for a three night stay to explore incredible Colonial highlights.

 (B,D) Overnight: **Williamsburg**

DAY 5: JAMESTOWN - YORKTOWN

Today a short ride brings you to **Jamestown**, founded in 1607 as the first permanent English settlement in the New World. Visit the restored full-scale Jamestown Settlement. Later visit **Yorktown**, where British commander Lord Cornwallis surrendered to Washington's troops in 1781. Recount the final days of the Revolution at the Yorktown Victory Center featuring exhibits and costumed interpreters recreating era daily life.

 (B) Overnight: **Williamsburg**

DAY 6: COLONIAL WILLIAMSBURG

Today visit Virginia's largest historical attraction, **Colonial Williamsburg**, a 173-acre living history museum. Start at the Visitor's Center then explore at your own pace the 88 restored and reconstructed 18th century buildings. Mingle with costumed townspeople and witness craftsmen demonstrations. Maybe visit Raleigh Tavern, the meeting place for Thomas Jefferson, Patrick Henry and other patriots. Tonight enjoy a traditional **Colonial Farewell Dinner** with your fellow travelers.

TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN (TPP) \$275 per person

The Pre-Departure Cancellation Fee Waiver (Part A – I & II) is provided by Chamber Explorations (CE) and is not an insurance benefit. The Post Departure Travel Insurance Plan (Part B) is provided by USI Affinity Travel Insurance Services (USI).

Part A – Cancellation Waiver provided by CE

I. Trip Cancellation Waiver (TCW) - Guarantees full refund on all payments, except the TPP Fee itself in case of cancellation up to the time and date of departure due to the passenger's personal illness or death of a member of the immediate family; or, if the passenger must return early due to the passenger's personal illness or death of a member of the immediate family, a refund for the unused land services. Medical/official documentation required.

II. Premier "Any Reason" Cancellation Waiver (ARCW) - Reimburses 75% of the cancellation fees in the form of a future travel credit certificate (FTCC) valid for 1 year, if you cancel more than 48 hours prior to scheduled departure for any reason not eligible for cash refund under the TCW (Part A – I.). FTCC is non-transferable, may not be redeemed for cash and does not include any credit for the TPP Fee. The TPP Fee (if chosen) is refundable until 180 days prior to departure & cannot be added after Final Payment.

The TPP does not cover any single supplement charges due to an individual's traveling companion cancelling prior to departure. The TPP is non-transferable and valid for each applicant only. The TPP does not cover any services such as airline tickets not purchased through CE. Cancellations, Claims & Inquiries under Part A will be administered by CE. Certain Exclusions and Restrictions apply.

Part B – Post Departure Travel Insurance Plan provided by USI
