How do I purchase Chamber Bucks?

Chamber Bucks can be purchased at the Marshalltown Area Chamber of Commerce office located in the lower level of Trinity Lutheran Church at 1011 S. 3rd Avenue.

Chamber Bucks come in \$5, \$10, and \$25 increments. We accept cash, check, or credit card for payment. Need to place a large order? You can pre-order Chamber Bucks by contacting Sarah Marckres at the Chamber office (office@marshalltown.org or 641-753-6645).

Where can I use my Chamber Bucks?

Chamber Bucks can be used at any business or organization that is a member of the Marshalltown Area Chamber of Commerce. In addition to redeeming Chamber Bucks at retail locations, you can use them to pay a utility bill or donate to a local charity/non-profit! Contact our office for an updated copy of the Chamber Bucks Redemption list.

How do I use my Chamber Bucks?

Chamber Bucks are treated like cash. Simply hand the Chamber Bucks over to the business or organization that you are redeeming them and that's it!

I am a Chamber member business/organization. How do I accept Chamber Bucks?

All Marshalltown Area Chamber of Commerce members can accept Chamber Bucks just like they would cash/check.

- 1. If the payment is more than the amount of the bill, simply give the customer change.
- 2. Be sure to stamp or otherwise clearly endorse the back of the check so that your organization name is clearly visible.
- 3. Deposit Chamber Bucks checks along with other checks and cash in your normal bank deposit. The full amount of the Chamber Bucks check will be credited to your account.

- 10. **Fourth of July fireworks.** Even the pandemic couldn't keep the fireworks show from going on in 2020. We can't wait until the 2021 version to keep the tradition going in Marshalltown.
