The Marshalltown Y campus includes the Horne-Henry Center, which is the primary location for health and wellness programs, swimming and aquatics, community and statewide events and sports. The Y's Cultural Center building houses our dance education program, preschool, day camp, the afterschool program and CrossFit 641.

As a nonprofit human services organization, the Y is meeting the needs of the community in a changing environment. 
