### Get to know our new President and CEO John Hall

John Hall started as the new President and CEO of the Marshalltown Area Chamber of Commerce on August 2.

Hall comes to Marshalltown from his post as Vice President of the Ames Chamber of Commerce and Economic Development Commission. His work at the Ames Chamber of Commerce focused on business and community development.

An Iowa State University graduate, Hall also holds a certification in economic development from the International Economic Development Council.

His experience in Ames had him serving as Executive Director for the Nevada Economic Development Council and Ames Main Street, in addition to leading the Ames Seed Capital organization.



#### Let's get to know John better in this Q & A.

#### What drew your interest to come to Marshalltown to lead the Chamber?

Having worked at the Ames Chamber of Commerce for the last 5 years, I knew that I wanted the opportunity to lead a Chamber of Commerce and when Marshalltown came available, it was the perfect opportunity. Knowing that Marshalltown is a strong community with great industry, and after meeting the Board of Directors and many members of leadership for the community, it became clear that my skillset could be a great fit and we would be able to accomplish some really exceptional things.

#### What are your short-term goals at the Chamber?

Immediately we have a couple of major items for us to address. First, we have had a long-time economic development position at our organization, but given my skillset in economic development, we will be pivoting that position into a workforce coordinator position. This will allow us to do a deep dive into the current labor force challenges locally, and allow us to help develop strategies in partnership with our industries to find ways to address these challenges. Second, is our need to find and build out new office space. There is high desire from our board and staff to locate our new offices in Downtown. It is clear that our current space was intended to be temporary and that we need to find and build a new home for us. Finally, we launched the Make Marshalltown Home Program back in June which will be an exceptional program to help us drive interest for new home purchasing in Marshalltown. That program has seen tremendous support locally, but we have an obligation to increase the marketing efforts of the program and to get that program's usage moving forward. *Continued on page 2*.

Did you know that the Small Business Administration (SBA) is partnering with local lenders to help secure financing needs with 7(a) and 504 loan programs? The 7(a) loan program even has some special terms for qualifying loans through September 30, 2021. Visit sba.gov/funding-programs/loans to learn more about SBA loan programs.

If your business is still feeling the effects of COVID, and the PPP loans were not quite enough, have you considered an Economic Injury Disaster Loan? These loans are administered directly by the SBA and are available until December 31, 2021. You can find more information at sba.gov.
