### **Community Ice Rink Officially Open**

The ice rink project is the result of a partnership between the Iowa Wild and MARSHALLTOWN Company, which is serving as the sponsor of the team's community rink program for the next three years. MARSHALLTOWN Director of Product Solutions and Customer Success Zach Stahlin explained that the roots of the collaboration were planted when some company employees attended a game and noticed the organization was using a product similar to their polar pusher snow shovel. Soon a partnership was born and plans for the ice rink came to life.

On Wednesday, January 17th the public was invited to celebrate the grand opening and ribbon cutting of the ice rink. The event had local vendors, giveaways, free skate rental, and so much more!

The City of Marshalltown will be operating an ice rink at 2 W Main Street (SW Corner of Main and Center St). When the rink is open and available for use there will be GREEN flags on the rink walls showing the ice is safe to use. If there are RED flags on the rink walls then the ice is not safe and the rink is not open for public use. The rink is open from dawn to 9pm. Other rules and safety guidelines are posted on signs located at the rink.

Skates may be rented for \$2/pair at the Marshalltown Parks & Recreation Office, 10 W State St (just 1 block north of the rink). Renters are asked to sign a rental agreement, and provide a credit card/debit number as a deposit. The office is open 8:30am-4:30pm, Monday - Friday. Skates can be rented for a 24-hour period on weeknights, or over the weekend (rent them on Friday and return them on Monday). Helmets are available at no charge with skate rentals, if requested.
